
Downtown Banner Project

Fire Safety and Prevention: Keeping Downtown San Angelo Safe

In recent months, San Angelo has experienced several fires in the downtown area, reminding us all of the importance of fire safety and prevention. As we continue to grow and thrive, it's essential that we understand how to protect our community, businesses, and historic buildings.

Here are a few key fire safety tips to keep in mind:

- 1. **Check Smoke Detectors Regularly-** Smoke detectors are essential in every building—whether you live or work downtown. Make sure they're functioning properly by testing them monthly and changing the batteries twice a year.
- 2. **Keep Fire Exits Clear-** For businesses, ensure that fire exits and escape routes are clear of obstacles. In case of an emergency, these exits need to be accessible to ensure safe evacuation.
- 3. **Create an Emergency Plan-** Every home and business should have an emergency plan that includes how to exit the building safely in the event of a fire, where to meet, and how to stay calm.
- 4. **Store Flammable Materials Properly-** Be mindful of how and where you store flammable materials, whether it's chemicals, oils, or even decorative items. These should be kept in a safe, well-ventilated area away from heat sources.
- 5. **Practice Safe Cooking-** Cooking is one of the most common causes of fires. Never leave a stove/ cooking utensils unattended, especially when using oils, grills, or other heat sources. Always keep a fire extinguisher nearby.

- 7. **Properly Dispose of Cigarettes-** If you smoke, ensure that cigarette butts are fully extinguished before disposing of them. Never discard cigarettes in planters or trash cans, as they can easily reignite.
- 8. **Maintenance**—Regularly check fire safety and prevention equipment to ensure everything is in working order. Additionally, conduct monthly or quarterly inspections of vacant properties to ensure there are no unwanted occupants.

Prevention is key to maintaining the safety and well-being of our downtown area. If you own a business or are responsible for a building, consider working with fire safety professionals to conduct a fire risk assessment. Regular maintenance, proper safety protocols, and awareness can go a long way in preventing fires from occurring.

We all share the responsibility of keeping Downtown San Angelo safe, and by taking a few simple precautions, we can protect the heart of our community and its residents for years to come.




